

In the recent years, cardiac health monitoring has seen tremendous improvement in terms of instrumentation and point of care. In a recent report by world bank, it is assessed that cardiovascular diseases would emerge as the main cause of death (36 per cent) in India by 2030. The aim of this workshop is to impart the necessary technical and clinical skills to understand the instrumentation and clinical aspects of cardiac health monitoring. The focus will be on non-invasive instrumentation for continuous monitoring of the physiological signals related to cardiac health. There will be hands on lab sessions to provide much needed practical understanding of the associated instrumentation. Lectures from cardiologists (medical doctors) will highlight the clinical engineering aspects of the cardiac health monitoring. A clinical demonstration by eminent cardiologist will be part of this workshop.

Main objectives of the workshop are:

- Develop necessary skills to understand essential instrumentation for cardiac health monitoring and imaging
- Develop knowledge to understand the noninvasive continuous monitoring of cardiac health parameters and interpretation.


