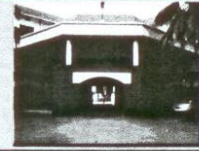

Contributed papers - An extended abstract of paper not exceeding 4 pages, based on the original work may be submitted. Subject category of the paper also to be indicated. It is planned to have both Oral and Poster presentations. The authors may indicate their choice while submitting the abstracts

Panel discussion - A panel of experts in respective field of instrumentation will meet to identify and resolve inter-disciplinary research problems.

Best Paper Award - Five best papers selected from both oral and poster presentations will be rewarded with cash prize and certificate of merit.

Invited Lectures - about 12 lectures are delivered by scientists/engineers on various areas of instrumentation and focal theme

Souvenir - Souvenir will contain the extended abstracts of invited and contributed papers. Advertisements from reputed instrument manufacturers are invited.

Product Exhibition - An exhibition by manufacturers of scientific instruments will help reach the end users in R&D field.

ISOI AWARD 2007 - This award would be presented to an outstanding scientist / engineer for significant contribution to the cause of instrumentation in India.
